Featured were Gil Peri, President of Riley's Hospital, Parri Black, CEO of Youthfirst, and Tracey Kelley of Southwestern Behavioral as they discuss the problem and solutions for youth experiencing mental and emotional crisis.

They discussed how the program works and the impact it has on Veterans and their families.

Candidates included Democrat Stephanie Terry, Republican Natalie Rascher, and Libertarian Micheal Daughtery.
